TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14 (2)

Kent County Council gives notice that Yelsted Lane, Yelsted will be closed to through traffic, on 18th January 2021 for up to 3 days.

The road will be closed outside New Cockhill Farm.

The alternative route is via Cox Street, Magpie Lane, onto Yelsted Road.

This closure is necessary to enable kerb installation works to be carried out by Kent County Council.

This Notice applies when the relevant signs and barriers are on site and is valid for a period of no more than 5 days.
